4. Event brief:

LEADER is an EU initiative, a method and programme instrument to support locally-driven rural development interventions to reinvent rural areas and create local jobs. The first LEADER programme started in EU Member States in 1991. The key actors of all local **LEADER/Community-Led Local Development initiatives** are the so-called **Local Action Groups (LAGs)** formed by local partners in a bottom-up way. LAGs are responsible for local governance in development and represent local authorities, businesses and civil society. LAGs decide on the territorial planning of their activities, establish formal partnerships, prepare and agree on integrated local rural development strategies (LDSs), identify and implement local development actions. The **LEADER approach** is based on **specific principles**, which are implemented simultaneously: "Go local" by implementing the territorial, bottom-up and partnership approach; Focus on integrated development, sustainability and inclusiveness. The development process is managed locally; networking and cooperation ensure mutual benefit from the experience.


Implementation of the **LEADER approach in Moldova started in 2015/2016** with the involvement of different partners and with the support of several donors, including the EU funded "SARD" Programme in the south part of the country (Gagauzia and Taraclia), the Pro Cooperare Regionala and HEKS-Eper MD in the north of the country. The first Moldovan Local Action Groups were launched in 2017/2018 and up to now more than 25 LAGs, covering approximately 30% of the Moldovan rural areas.

Several LAGs, with a total budget of approx. 0.5 million Euro, have managed local development calls and implemented more than 160 pilot local projects in 2108.











The National LEADER Network of Moldova includes as members, all Moldovan LAGs, LEADER-like initiatives and organisations that facilitate the process of implementation of the LEADER approach in Moldova. The LEADER Conference will also to mark the official launch of the National LEADER Network of Moldova, which was created in late 2018 on the initiative of several partners, including: The Moldovan Ministry of Agriculture Regional Development and Environment, the EU Delegation in Chisinau, the EU-SARD Programme, CRAION CONTACT-Cahul, Pro Cooperare Regionala, HEKS Moldova, PIN Moldova and the Solidarity Fund PL.

The main goal of the event is to present and promote implementation of the EU rural development approach – LEADER / CLLD in Moldova.

The Conference will assemble approx. **25-30 Moldovan Local Action Groups** and will provide **networking opportunities**, both at national and EU level and an **open-air fair** for the sale of the local products of the LAG members, as well as **field visits** to the selected Moldovan LAGs territories.

Within the framework of the Conference, the following side-events are planned:

- Signing of the formal LAG Partnership Agreements by the members of 8 new Moldovan Local Action Groups created within USAID supported "LEADER Activity" project;
- Signature of the financial agreements between 15 Moldovan LAGs and Solidarity Fund PL in Moldova for the implementation of pilot LEADER projects in 2019;
- signing of the official declaration by the Moldovan National LEADER Network to join the European LEADER
 Association for Rural Development (ELARD);
- Signing of the partnership agreement between 12 EU LAGs and 3 Moldovan LAGs (LAG Serpentina Nistrului, LAG Movila Magurii and LAG Bugeac Kilim) for the implementation of a trans-national cooperation project under LEADER 2014-2020 with the title "Say cheese! Balkan cheese" project;
- signing of cooperation agreement between National LEADER Network of Romania and the National LEADER
 Network of Moldova;
- signing the financial agreements between Moldovan LAGs and the Solidarity Fund PL in Moldova for financing LEADER activities in 2019;
- presentation of the evaluation study about LEADER in Moldova;

On the last day of the event **three** (3) optional **field visits to selected Moldovan LAGs** will be organised for the participants to discover the beauty of Moldovan rural zones as well as to present the results of the LEADER activities in Moldova in 2018 (success story pilot LEADER projects).

This multi-cultural event gathering people from different rural regions of Moldova will be organized in the very centre of Chisinau, at the Palace of the Republic. The open-air-fair will demonstrate the distinctive characteristics of almost all Moldovan LAGs and the field-visits will help reduce urban, rural, ethnic and political barriers and show **how rural Moldova can be revitalised** and how it can become a **source of inspiration for other EU partners**.
